PROJECT 1: Love of Others

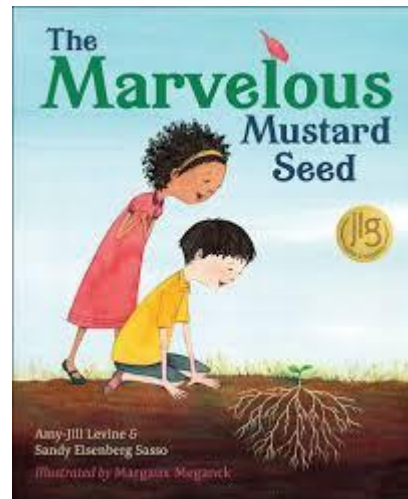
- Find out about our king, King Charles III. You could extend this research to the Royal Family.

PROJECT 7: Love of Self

- Visit your local Library. Introduce yourself to the Librarian and join the Library if you are not already a member.
- Find out what you can do in the Library.
- Choose at least two books to borrow from the Library to read at home.

PROJECT 8: Love of Life!

Tell, show, draw, demonstrate, design or create a project on a topic of your own interest which shows you love life!

PROJECT 3: Love of Others

- Use your Purple Mash log in (inside your Reading Record front cover) to explore Purple Mash with your family. Remember to save anything you do in your 'My Work' folder, date it and mark on this sheet that it is done.

PROJECT 4: Love of God's World

Visit Reading, Newbury or another town/city:

- Consider the human and physical features.
- Find out about the history of the name.
- Draw a map to show the land use and transport network.
- Find your favourite place.
- Find out if anyone important lived there.
- Write a brief letter that could be sent to the relevant authority saying what you liked about the place and how it could be improved.

- Find out about a local or World charity that helps those in need. How might you support the work they do?

PROJECT 6: Love of God

- Use a children's Bible or video clips to help you to understand a variety of Bible stories. Consider whether each story is found in the Old or New Testament. Link each story to one or more of our school values.
