### PROJECT 1: Love of Others

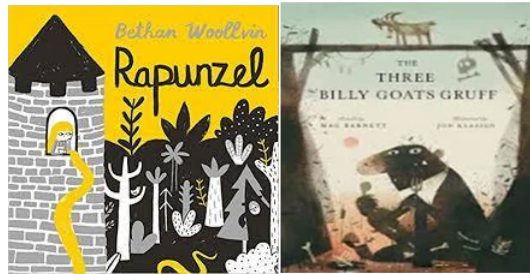
- Consider a New Year's Resolution for you to do which shows our value 'Love of Others'.

### PROJECT 7: Love of Self

- Visit your local Library. Introduce yourself to the Librarian and join the Library if you are not already a member.
- If you have done the above, continue to enjoy the Library. Record your reading in the Reading Record. Which book did you like best and why?

### PROJECT 8: Love of Life!

Tell, show, draw, demonstrate, design or create a project on a topic of your own interest which shows you love life!

### PROJECT 3: Love of Others

- Use your Purple Mash log in (inside your Reading Record front cover) to explore Purple Mash with your family. Remember to save anything you do in your 'My Work' folder, date it and mark on this sheet that it is done.

### PROJECT 4: Love of God's World

- Help your family with the recycling at home. Why is it important to recycle whenever possible?
- Make a poster showing how we can be more aware of loving God's World in school e.g. Turning off taps/lights.

### PROJECT 5: Love of Others
